Thriving Together NCW Mission

The mission of Thriving Together NCW is to advance health and wellbeing in North Central Washington by unifying partners, supporting collaboration, and enabling systems change.

Funding Purpose

We know that not one single person or organization can solve the complex health issues specific to our region, which is why we partner with local organizations each year to fund projects that improve health and wellness in the North Central region.

The purpose of this funding is to support events in Chelan, Douglas, Grant, and Okanogan counties that focus on removing obstacles keeping individuals from reaching their full potential. This focus enables us to support projects across the region that are making a positive impact in our local communities by advancing whole-person health.

Important Definitions

Health Equity: Health equity means that everyone has a fair and just opportunity to reach their full health potential.

Whole Person Health: a state of complete physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being (not just the absence of disease) which includes a person's sense of purpose and meaning in their life.

Social Determinants of Health: conditions in the environments where people are born, live, learn, work, and play that affect a wide range of health and quality of life outcomes. Social determinants of health can be grouped into 5 categories: economic stability, education access and quality, health care access and quality, neighborhood and built environment, social and community context.

Eligibility Information

This funding opportunity is open to partners with an existing physical presence (staff and/or office) in Chelan, Douglas, Grant, and Okanogan Counties. The organization does not need to be headquartered in these counties.



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You do not have to have a history of participating in Thriving Together NCW's work to apply.

We do not fund traditional fundraising events or Galas. This should be an event that directly engages the people you plan to serve/benefit.

If you do not have an official 501(c) non-profit or business status, you must have a partnership with an organization who can enter into contracts and act as your fiscal sponsor and receive the dollars on your behalf.

In order to be eligible, your proposal must be aligned with Thriving Together NCW's mission and the purpose of this particular funding. Awarded amounts will be based on how closely the application aligns with the funding of this purpose.
